BCAUSEICAN Metro Spotlight Charity

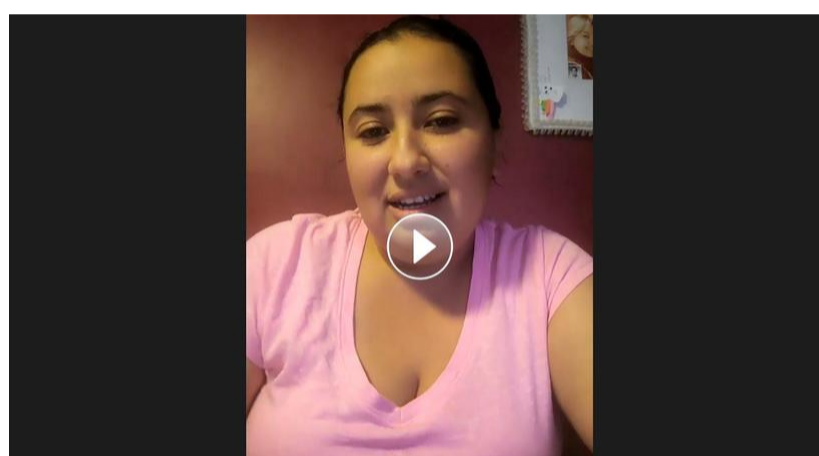
BCAUSEICAN has been selected as the Accenture 2021

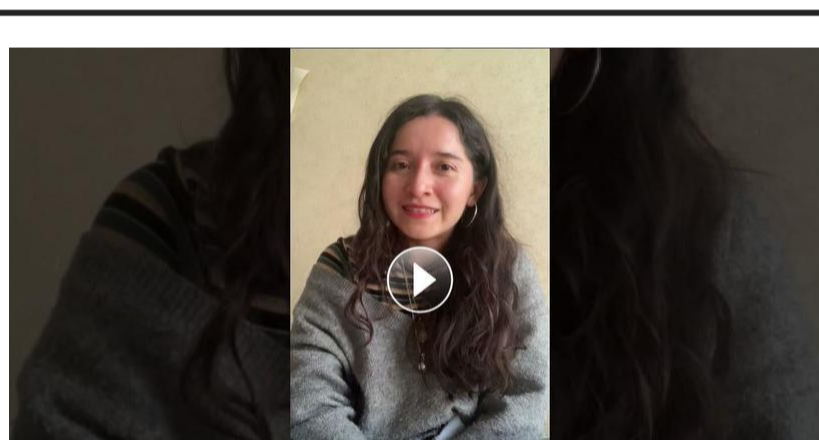
Instructor Spotlight- Amanda Leon

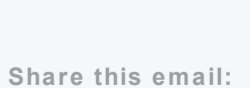

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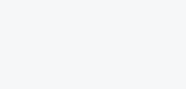
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
